Designed by architects Buzzi, Bernasconi, and Baptiste, NICE ACROPOLIS Convention Center opened its doors in 1984 and was inaugurated in May 1985 when the prestigious Apollo auditorium was completed. Formerly known as Parc Expo, this center hosts various conventions, fairs, concerts, operas, productions of shows and exhibitions. Its layout was carefully designed: gardens, fountains, and numerous works of art are on exhibit outside the building.

WEATHER

Nice has a hot-summer Mediterranean climate.

The day-time temperature in early September ranges between 17 and 25 °C. Rain is possible.



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LANGUAGE

The main language of the congress will be English, but simultaneous interpretation in French available in all rooms. Interpretation will also be available in Spanish.

CLOTHING

Business casual for all occasions.

BADGES

All delegates and guests will receive a name badge at the registration desk.

The badge will be the official meeting document and should be worn at all times in order to gain entry into the meeting rooms and exhibition halls. Badges are nominative. Any reissue of badge will be charged. The circulation of two identical badges simultaneously will be identified. With a delegate's badge, participation will be granted into the scientific programme. Admission to the congress will not be allowed without badge identification.
